BEACH/TOWN BEAUTIFICATION & IMPROVEMENTS:

- Repair & replace info signs along boardwalk. While a Public Works issue these are ignored.
- Cleanup the weeds, bushes and trees growing out of the retaining wall and clean up the walkway / rusty handrails (both areas along Front street); It's ugly and takes away from the beauty. Remove all the painted rocks. That's just wrong! (and an eyesore)
- Cleaning and landscaping. Beaches and walkways need to be clean and this requires labor to assess and address on a regular basis, including public restrooms.
- Items to help keep the area clean and tidy, such as additional trash and recycle containers. Historical landmarks, interpretive signage.
- Replace the painfully noisy leaf blowers with a quieter brand. Or use good old-fashioned brooms and rakes! Have you ever watched those guys blowing sand around?--totally inefficient! I bet a time-and-motion study would show the job does not actually get done any faster with the blowers. BTW: 1. there ARE quieter leaf blowers; 2. many communities are banning leaf blowers. It is definitely a well-recognized, valid quality-of-life issue.

BEACHES/TRAILS/PUBLIC ACCESS AREAS:
