- c. 2024 Board of Trustees
 - 1. Richard Zacky is retiring from the Board after 10 years of service.
 - 2. Distributions of ballots for 2024 elections Barbara requested all Board members turn in their ballots. Rick C. confirmed that the results will be announced in the January meeting.
- **d. 2024 meeting schedule under construction** Rick R. announced it is a similar schedule with days of the week and time of the month as 2023.
- e. 2024 Operating budget under construction Rick R. announced that this is the case.
- **f. Signature card update for Founder's Community Bank** Rick C. reported that to add Rick R. to the bank account and the new credit card, there needs to be approval in the minutes. Barbara made a motion to approve Rick R. as a signer on the checking account and to receive the foundation credit card in his name, Joe seconded and all approved.
