- a. Review Feedback on Storytellers Night Over 100 people attended the event including several board members and we have been receiving very positive feedback. - **b. Update Public Art Phase II Donations** 46 donors have contributed a total of \$20,670 to date. Balance of \$4,330 will be contributed from the Foundation trustee account which was agreed upon at the October 16<sup>th</sup> board meeting.
