Bellevue - Santa Fe Charter School

Part of the funds would be a matching grant with the US Dept. of Education for Ipads for 6<sup>th</sup> graders. Bellevue expressed the important of technology in learning. They currently have 32 ipads, there is \$7,000 left in the Dept. of Education grant. 50% of their school is from the Avila valley. Students would not keep the ipads to future grades, and ipads are kept at the school, and Apple does provide a discount. Belleuvue also provides training for teaches so they are on the cutting edge of technology in learning. It is feasible for Bellevue to do a matching grant. Bellevue has recently upgraded their infrastructure so they can handle the bandwidth required for the additional ipads.
